What can your national organization do to promote reauthorization of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act (JJDPA)?

- Educate your national colleagues and your members/constituents about the JJDPA—a fact book and explanatory pages are housed on the Act-4-JJ Web site, see: <http://www.act4jj.org>
- Join the Act-4-JJ e-mail list by signing up at: info@act4jj.org to receive regular updates and news from the campaign.
- Help to educate hill staffers and members of Congress, by:
 - attending hill briefings, hearings and events;
 - sending letters to members of Congress on your organization's letterhead to urge their support of the Act-4-JJ campaign's positions;
 - asking your members/constituents to send Act-4-JJ postcards to members of Congress to draw attention to key areas of concern (*download from Web site*).
- Enlarge the circle of support for a strong and progressive reauthorization of the JJDPA, by:
 - Signing or getting others to sign the "Statement of Principles for Reauthorization of the JJDPA" for delivery to Congress (*download from Web site*).
 - Attending monthly meetings of the National Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Coalition (NJJDPC) to receive in-person updates, analysis and resources for field activities.
