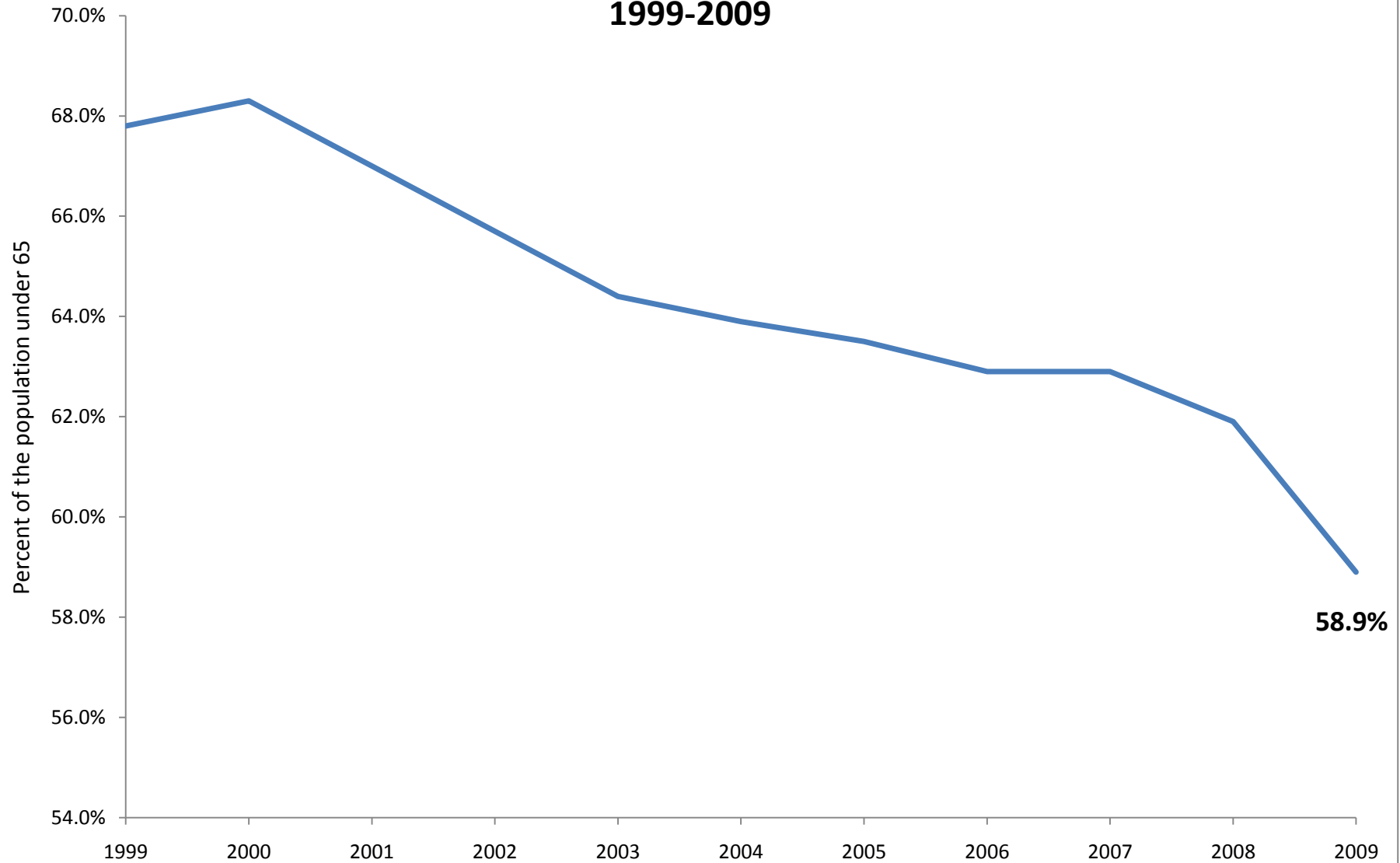

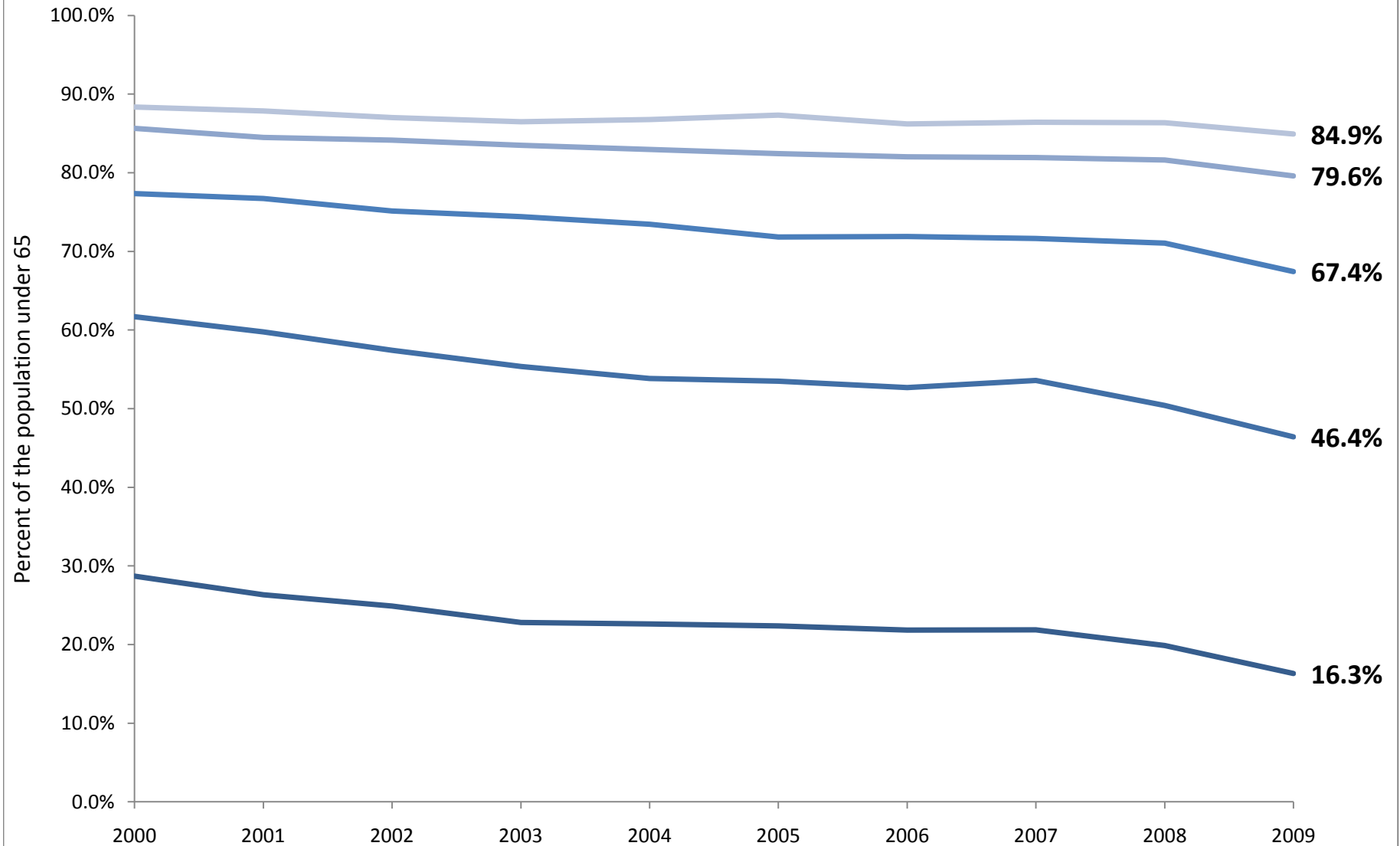

Share of the under 65 population with employer-sponsored insurance, 1999-2009



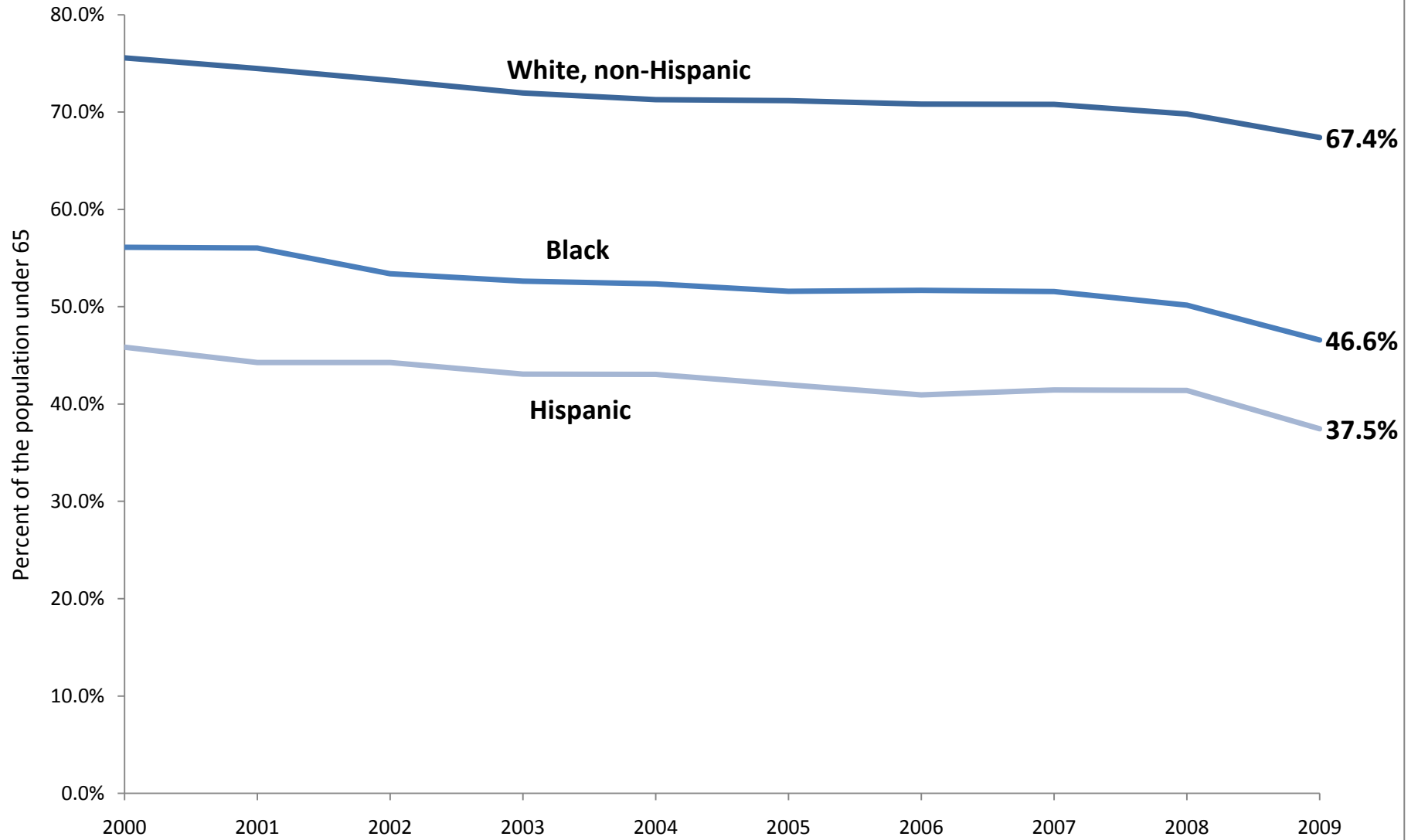

Share of the under 65 population with ESI by income fifth, 2000-2009



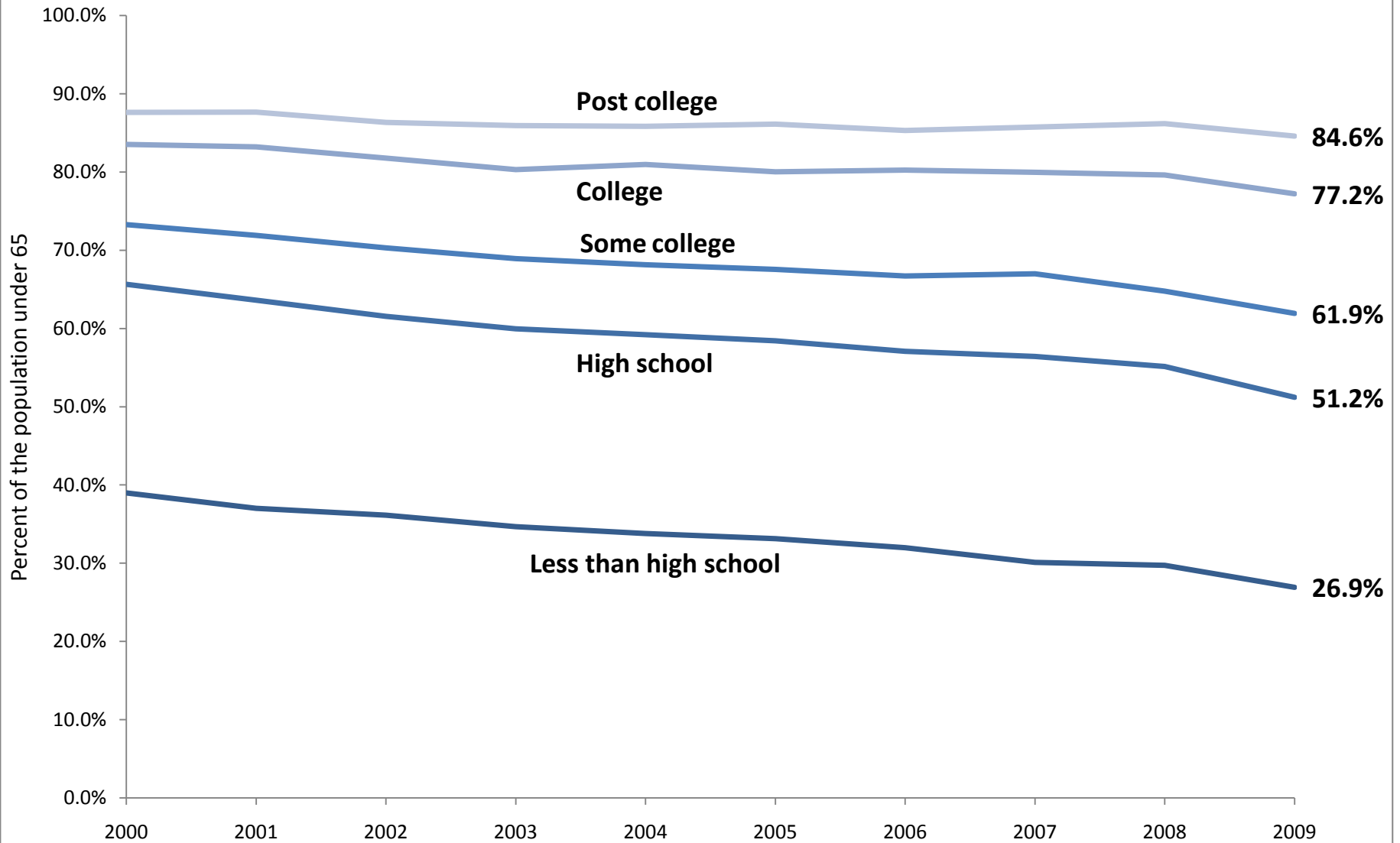

Share of the under 65 population with ESI by race, 2000-2009



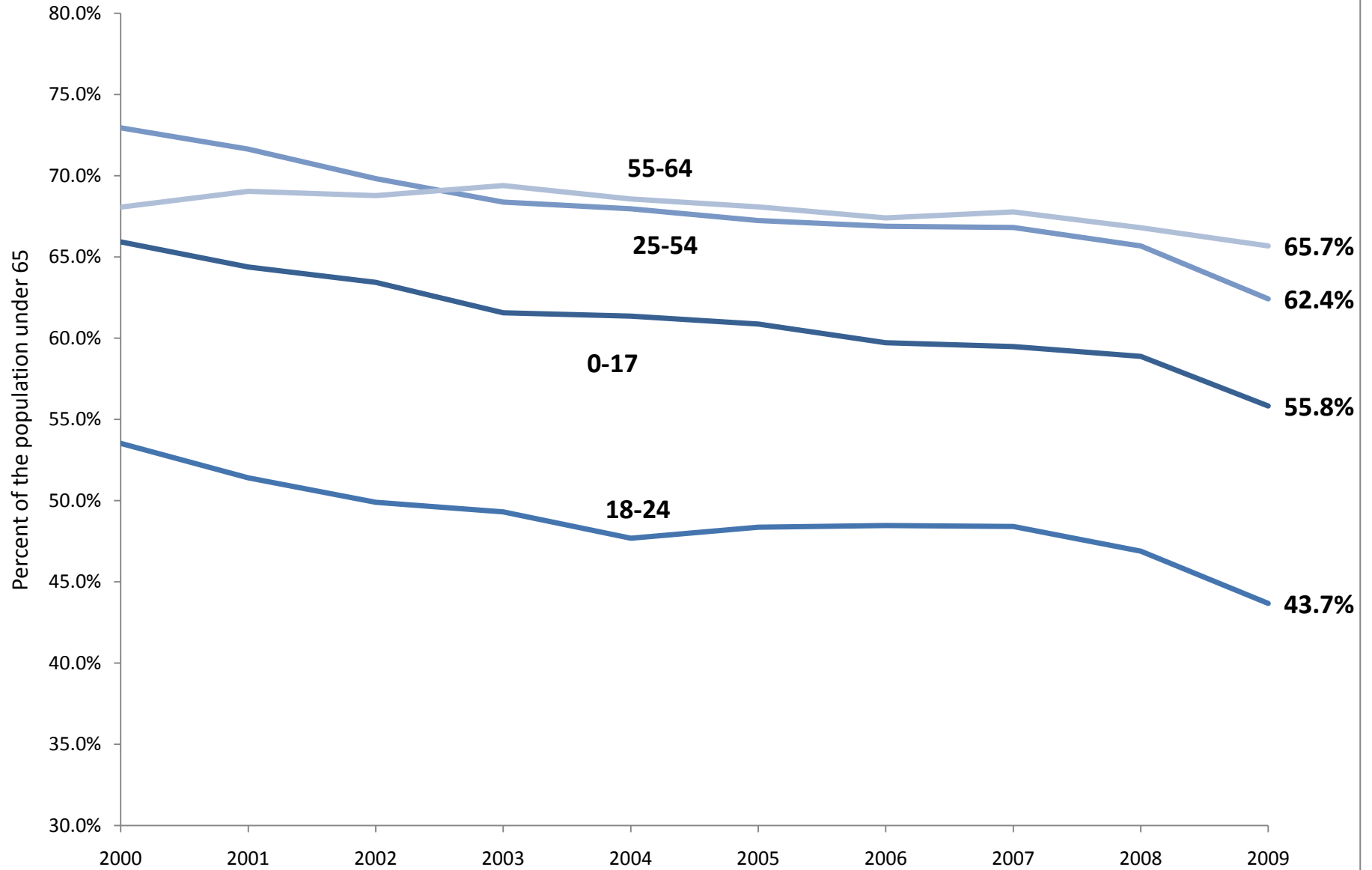

Share of the under 65 population with ESI by education, 2000-2009



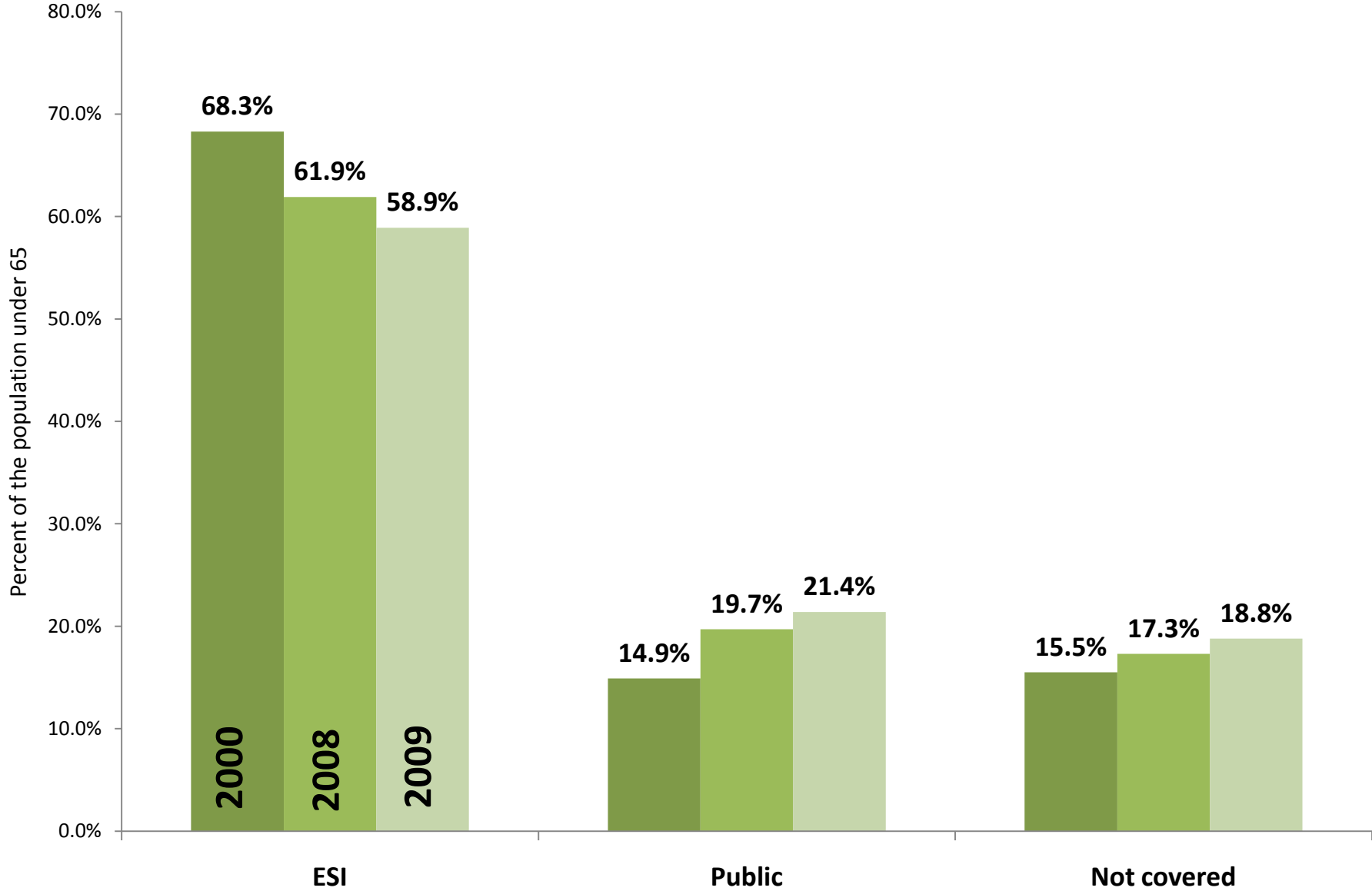

Share of the under 65 population with ESI by age, 2000-2009



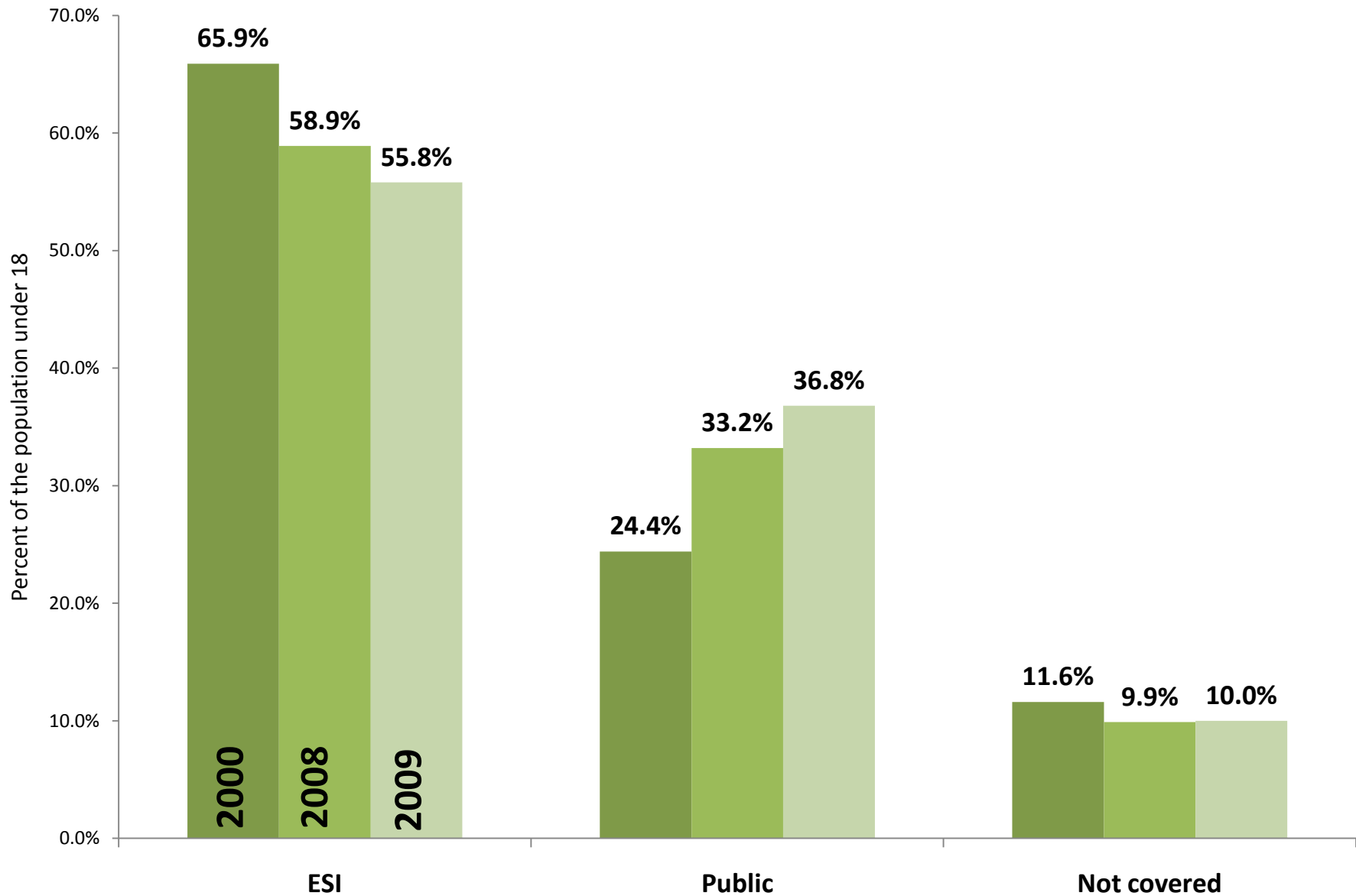

Sources of health insurance coverage for population under 65



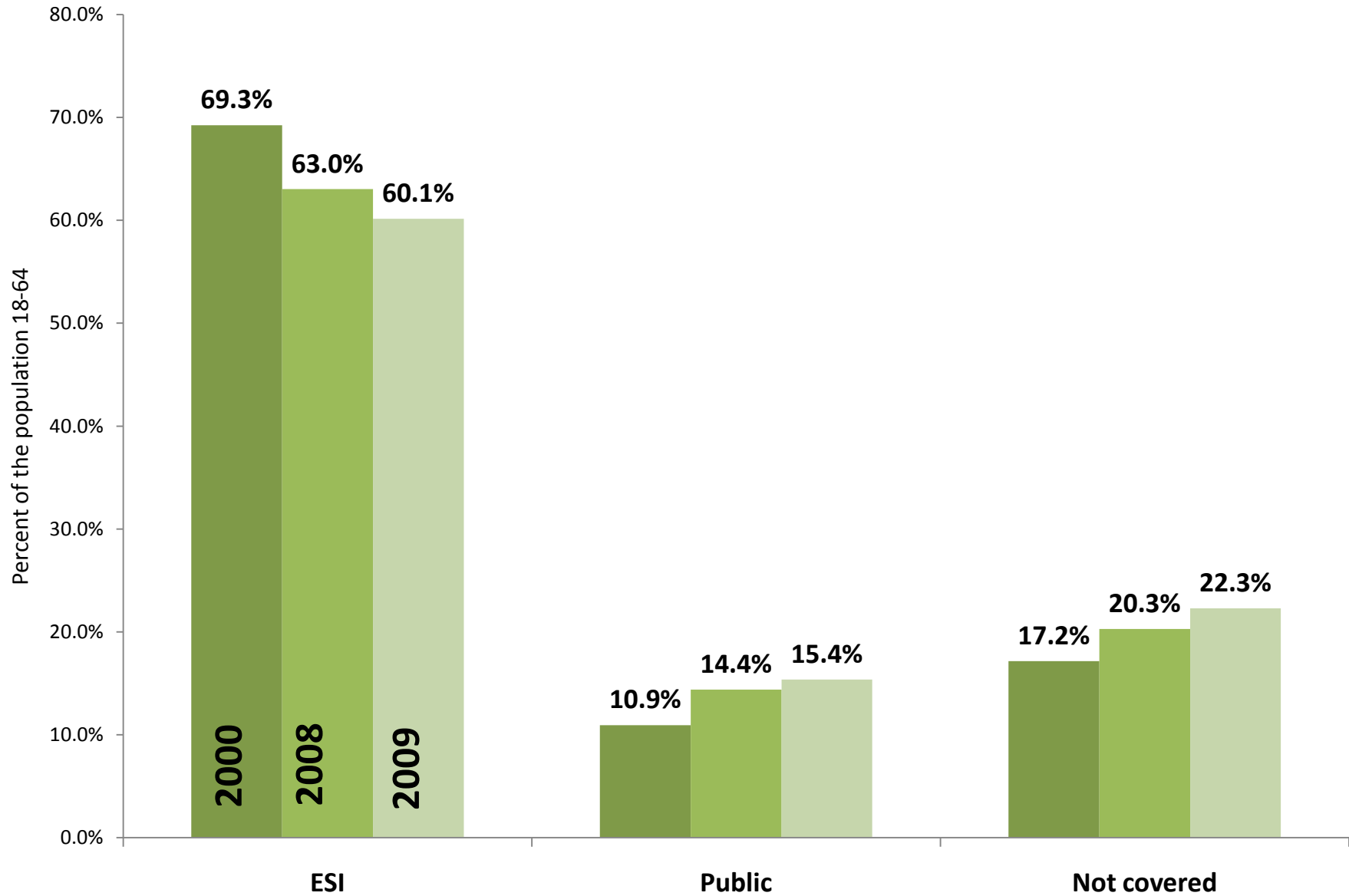

Sources of health insurance coverage for population under 18



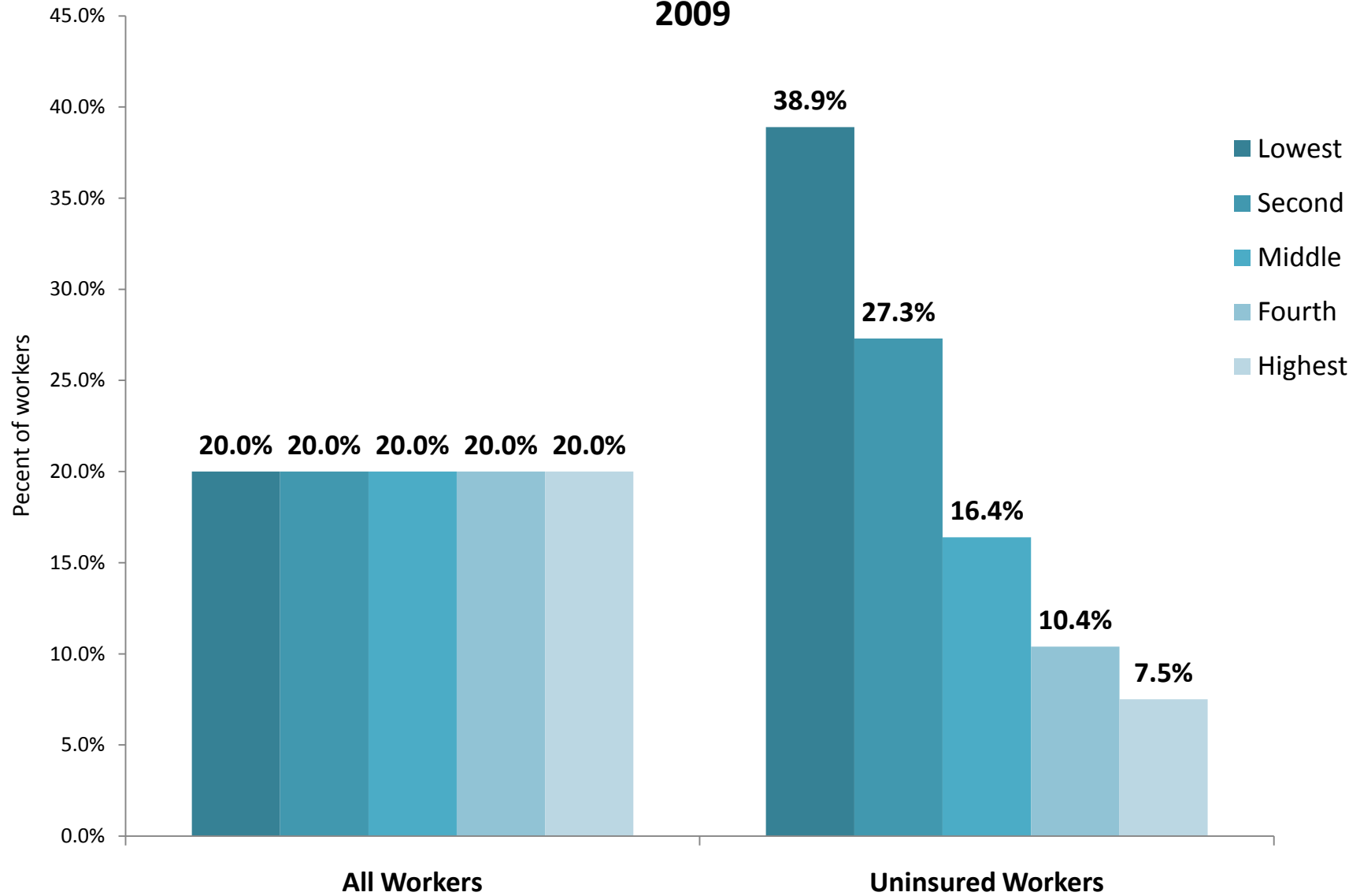

Sources of health insurance coverage for population 18-64



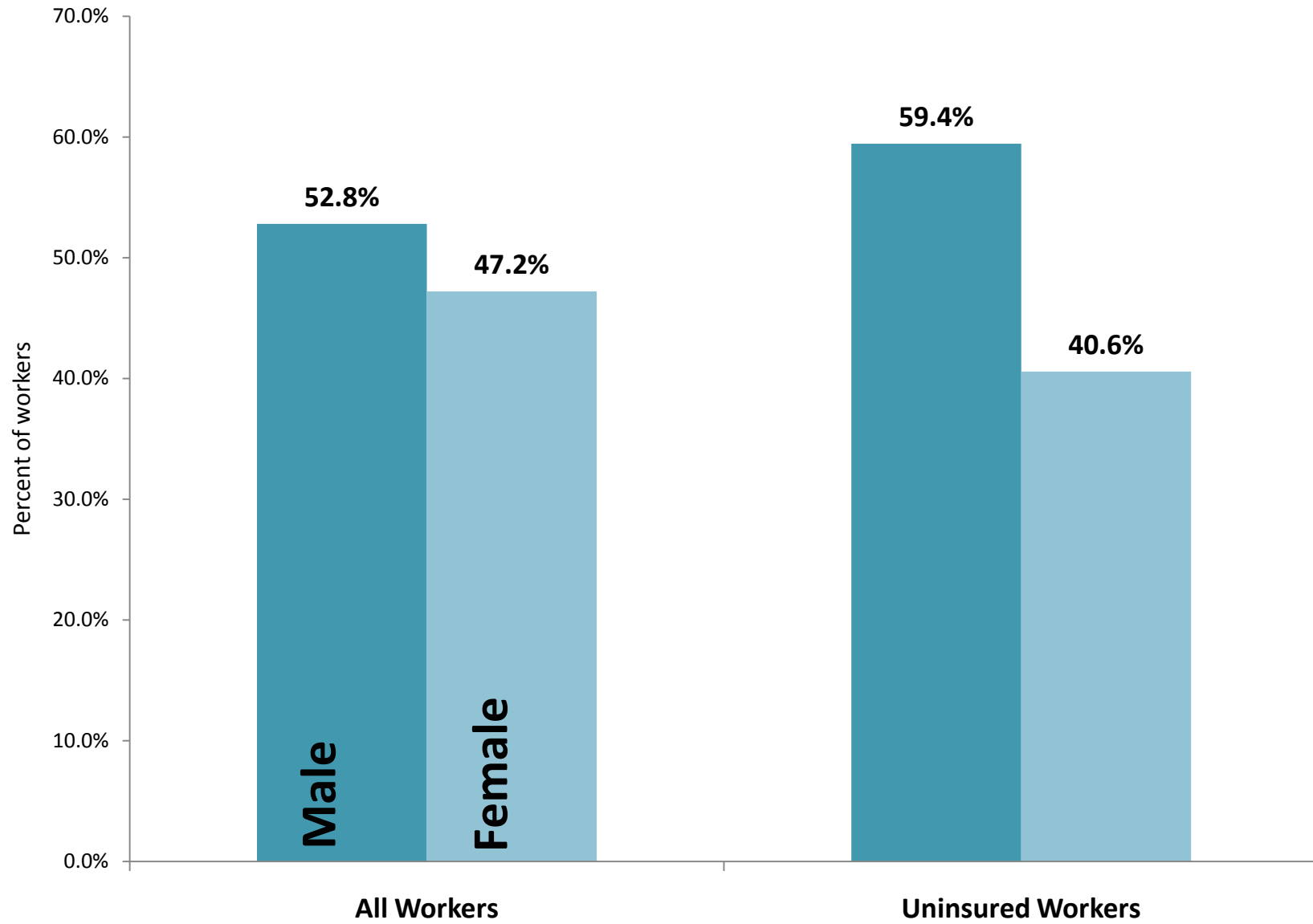

Share of all workers vs. share of uninsured workers by wage quintile, 2009



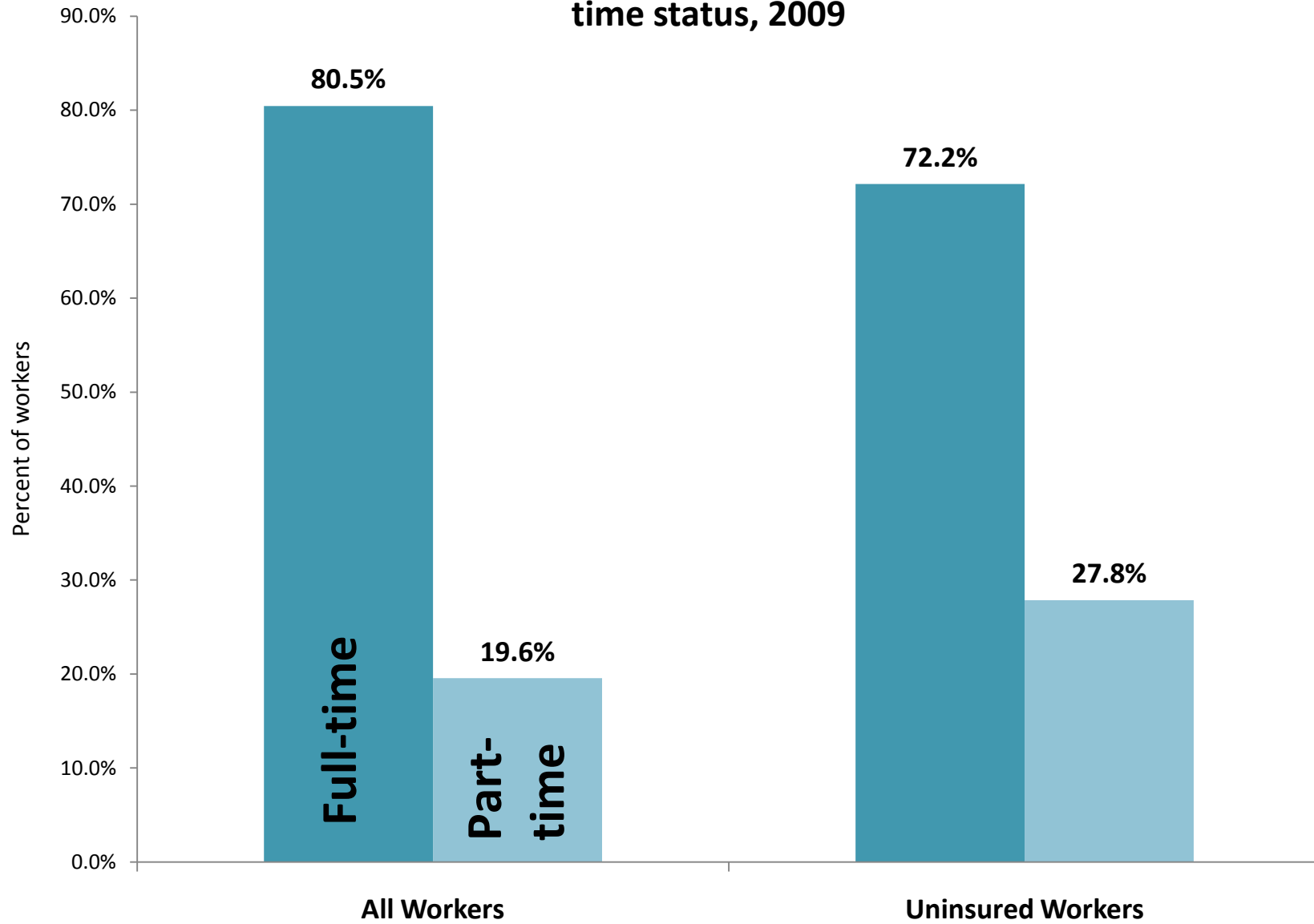

Share of all workers vs. share of uninsured workers by gender, 2009



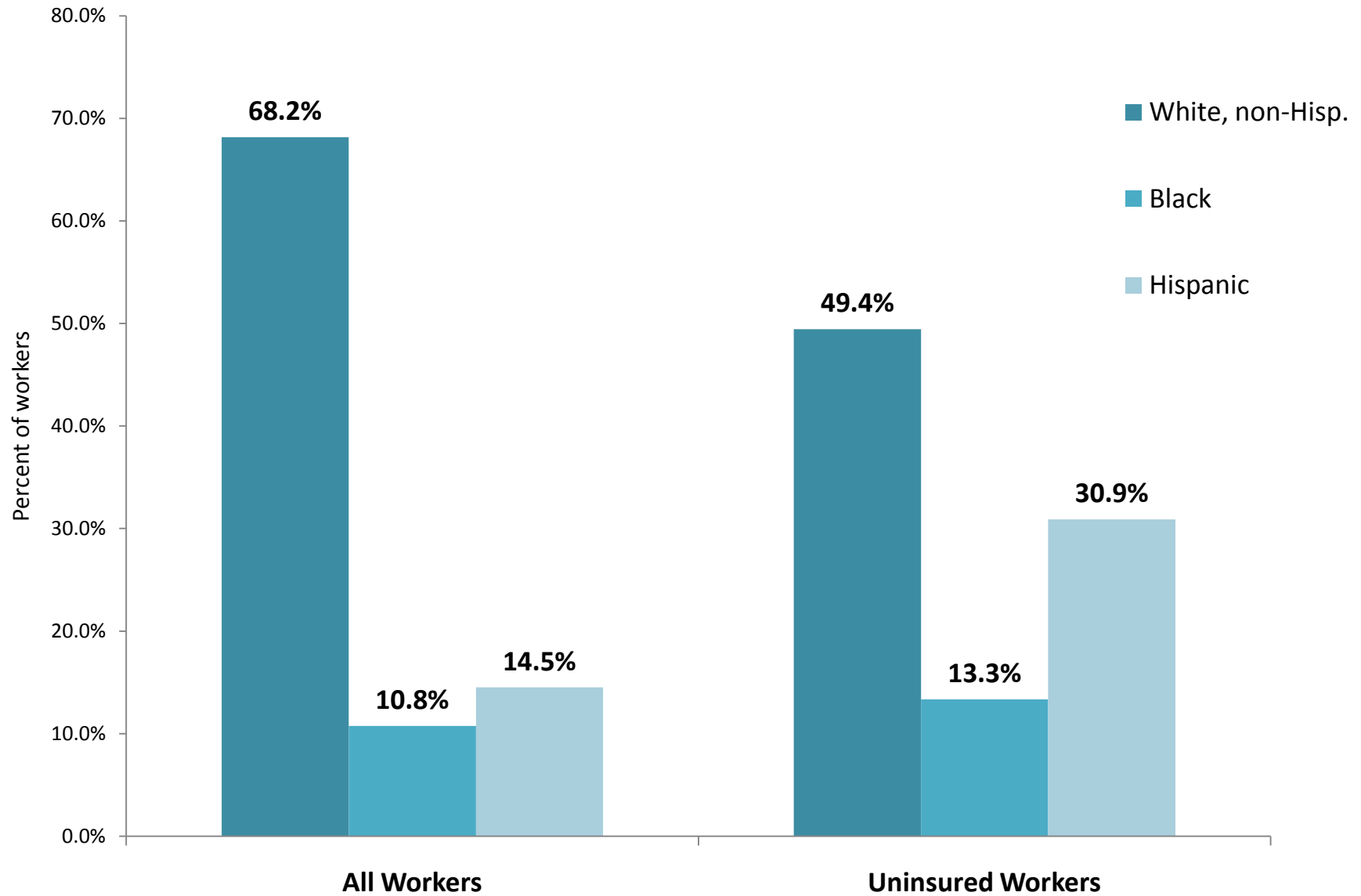

Share of all workers vs. share of uninsured workers by full-time or part-time status, 2009



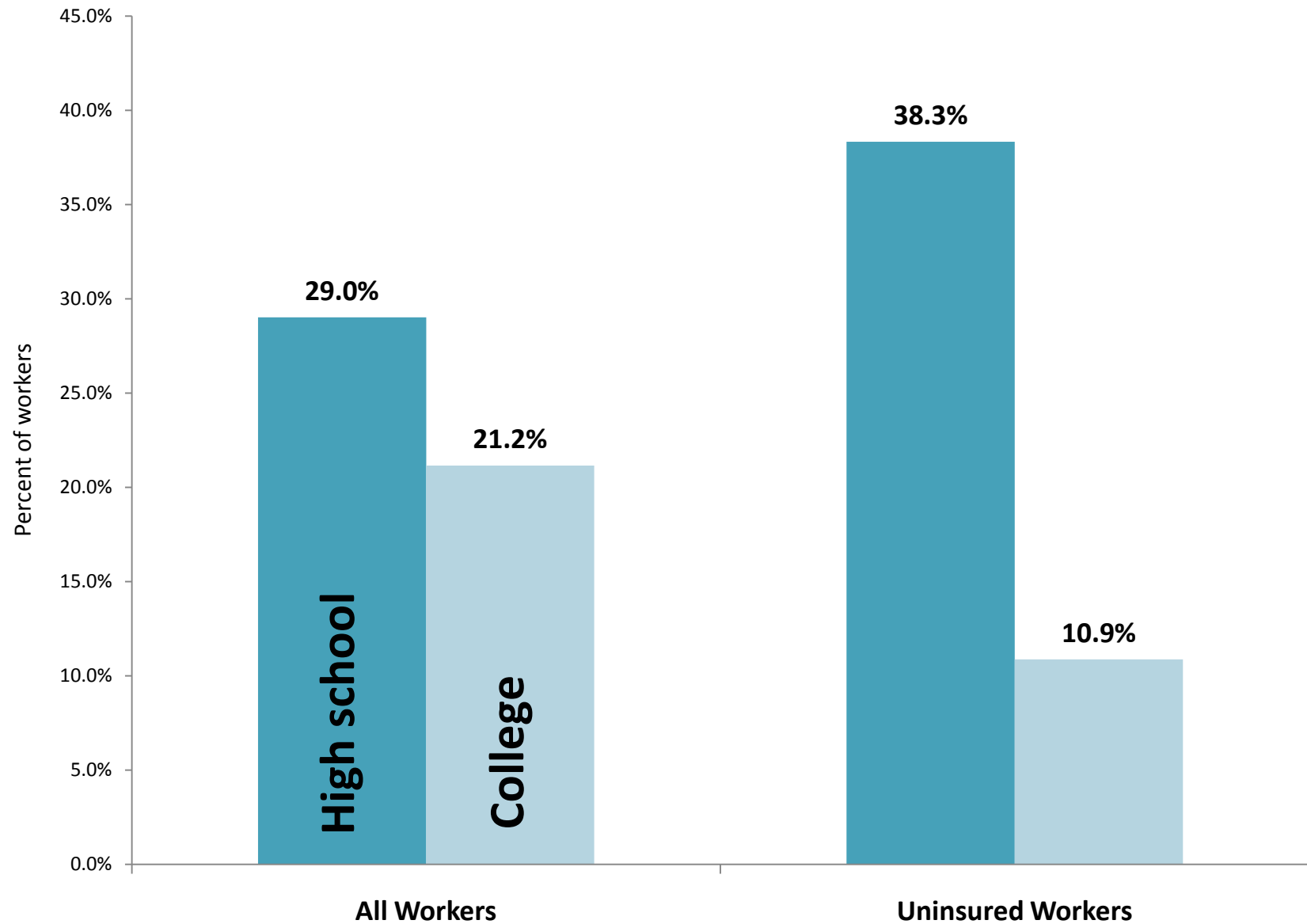

Share of all workers vs. share of uninsured workers by race, 2009



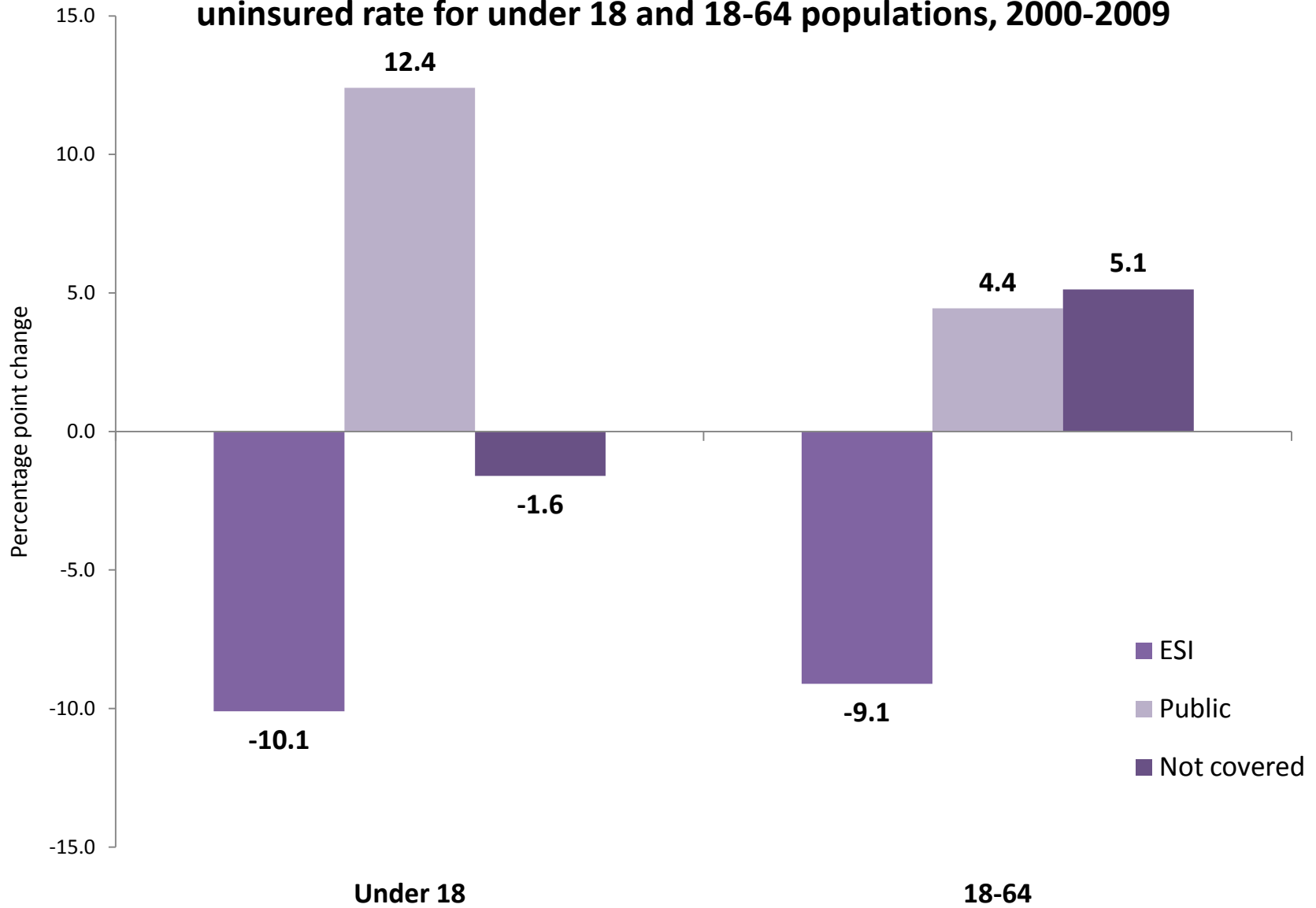

Share of all workers vs. share of uninsured workers by education, 2009



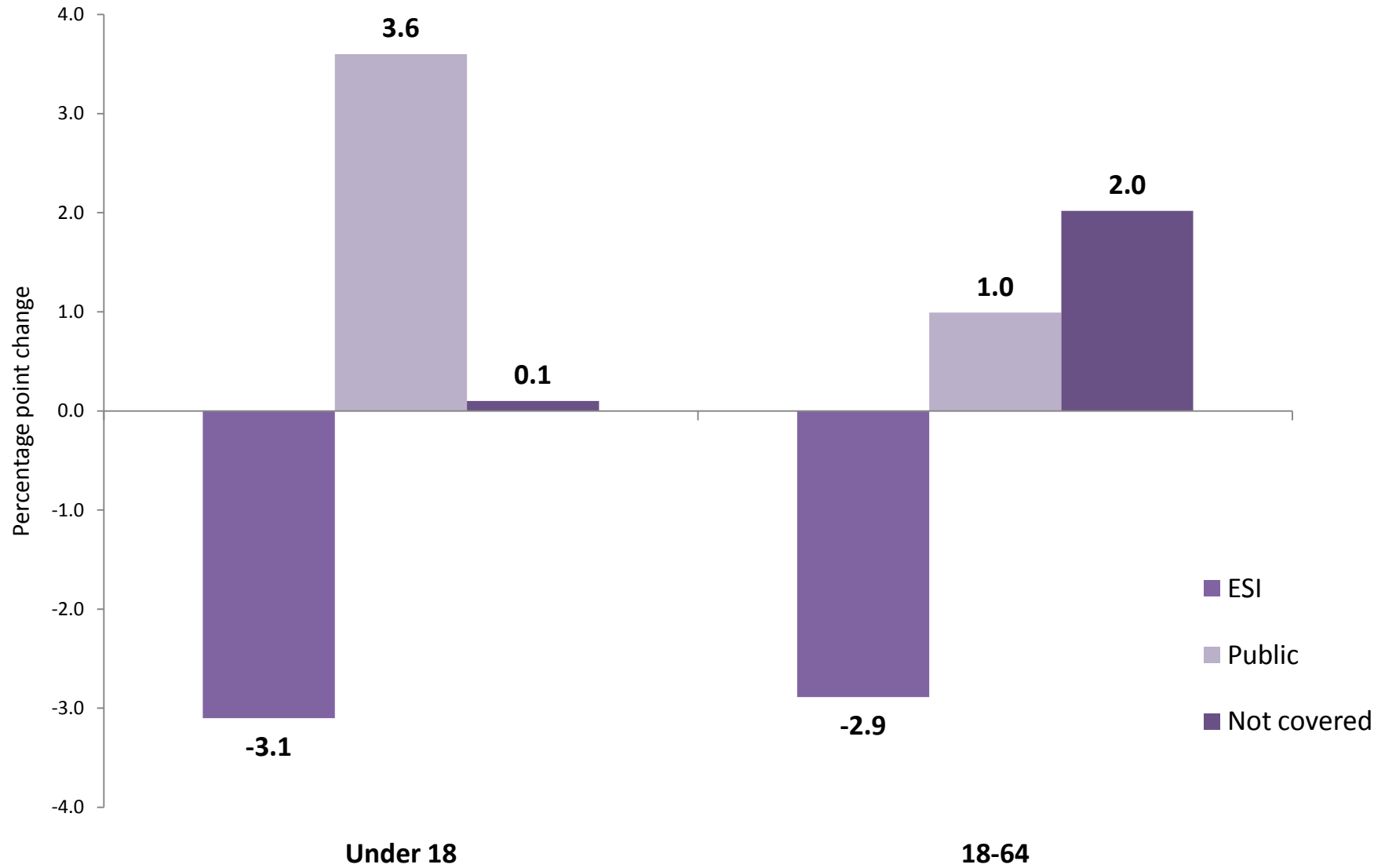
